INSPECTION CERTIFICATION:

I hereby certify that the containers at the Collection Entity/Site identified above were inspected on the date listed above. Based on a visual examination, the collected mini-bulks/shuttles were judged to have been triple-rinsed or pressure rinsed per ANSI/ASABE S596 FEB2006 protocol. All mini-bulk/shuttle(s) have to be cut up into pieces no larger than 24" wide and are free of metal, gaskets, and any other foreign material. The blow molded HDPE will be recycled at ACRC approved end use mfg and the roto-molded HDPE will be used in the mfg of septic tanks.

Please Note:

- The base to asset tanks should be left in tact and not cut into pieces.
- Storage tanks that have not been approved by USDOT for transportation are NOT included in this program. The majority of these tanks include "cross-link" and cannot be recycled.
- The cut up Mini-Bulk/IBCs can be placed in a cut open IBC (top removed) or stacked and banded on a pallet.
- If mini-bulk/shuttles(s) received by CSN Service Center do not meet agreed CSN specifications, Collection Entity/Site agrees to take back said mini-bulk/shuttle(s) and pay all return freight charges.
